



TERMS AND CONDITIONS

To qualify for early bird registration, registration fees must be paid in full by 14 July 2021. Registration fees received after this date will revert back to the standard congress applicable rate. Registration fees are based on date of payment receipt, not the date of receipt of registration form.

After 21 July 2021 midnight AEST, only payment made by credit card will be accepted.

The overwhelming importance of the Congress Committee is the health and safety of our delegates, sponsors and exhibitors, your communities and our industry. In the event of travel bans, border closure, restrictions on large gatherings, or other impacts due to Covid-19 pandemic or other conditions, the conference will move from a hybrid event to a virtual conference/congress. By registering to attend, you accept that the date of the conference may change under these conditions.

If moved to virtual only the Congress will refund the difference in registration fee between in-person and virtual rates. In the case that the delegate does not wish to attend the Congress virtually, no full refunds will be given, only the difference in the fee will be refunded.

As a condition of attendance, in-person delegates must agree to adhere to all Covid-safe measures put in place by the Australasian Diabetes Congress 2021, the venue or state and acknowledge that these procedures may be changed at any time in accordance with the latest health advice from the Australian Government.

CANCELLATION CONDITIONS

Change from a full registration to virtual registration component only can be accepted if no in-person attendance is possible. The difference between full registration and virtual registration cost will be refunded if advised via email by 14 July 2021.

Cancellations received in writing at the Congress Office 14 July 2021 will be accepted and all fees refunded less an administrative fee of AUD \$100. Cancellations received after this date cannot be accepted and will not be refunded (in part or full).

If your application for a visa to enter Australia is unsuccessful, the above cancellation terms apply.

Transfer of registration: Transfer of your registration to another person within your organisation is acceptable. The full name and details of the person that will replace you must be advised in writing to the Congress Office prior to the Congress.

Non-attendance: No refunds will be made for non-attendance at the Congress.
